



Dear applicant for vendor positions at the WIBF:

This document is intended to help potential vendors of the “Global Artisans Village” of the WIBF 2019 Vancouver, Canada.

Context information:

Any vendors participating should be committed to increasing community spirit and pride and to celebrate cultural heritage and diversity.

Vendors should be Indigenous artisans and entrepreneurs, presenting and allowed to sell crafts, art, handmade musical instruments, jewelry, delicatessen, sweets and preserves, organic handmade personal care products, etc.

Vendors should apply and send their request to be considered to [info@ildii.ca](mailto:info@ildii.ca) providing their background, bio and pictures of their products. Vendors will have the opportunity to showcase and sell their products. They must be Indigenous artisans with products of cultural and /or artistic relevance. Vendors will be responsible for their own costs and if additional services are required (electrical), you will be provided with a contact at the venue to order on your own.

Vendor will receive one courtesy registration for WIBF and additional “co-owners/helpers” will be required to purchase a registration at a SME fee of \$749. Space allocated to each vendor will be 10’ x 10’ equipped with a 6 foot table (black linen) and chairs.

There is a limited amount of available spots in the “Global Artisans Village”, and the distribution of spots will rest in the “Global Artisans Village” sub-committee and WIBF organizers. Balanced national-international criteria will be pursued. Sponsorship of artisans will be considered and applications from sponsors will be accepted.
